SHANGRI-LA RASA RIA, KOTA KINABALU



LOCATION

Situated amid the lush tropical vegetation and white sandy beach of Pantai Dalit, the resort is just 40 minutes from Kota Kinabalu International Airport and 35 minutes from the city's shopping and commercial district.

RASA RIA RESERVE

The Rasa Ria Reserve, a 64-acre tropical jungle nestled at the foot of Sabah's iconic Mount Kinabalu - a UNESCO World Heritage Site – brings hotel guests closer to Sabah by experiencing Malaysia's Culture, Adventure and Nature.

The reserve is home to incredible varieties of flora and fauna, 64 bird species, 100 types of butterflies and indigenous wildlife including the endangered and protected Pangolin.

Split into two distinctive zones – Nature Reserve and Adventure Point - the 64-acre Rasa Ria Reserve provides the natural habitat for visitors with a passion for learning and experiential experiences.

At the heart of the Rasa Ria Reserve, a new Discovery Centre educates through tactical exhibitions. The rangers nurture the reserve with the maintenance of the natural surroundings to ensure prosperity in both fauna and flora, plus animals, available to view from guided walking trails.

Adventure Point

Designed in harmony with the reserve, the Adventure Point enhances an open space for young visitors. It is home to Bornean animal play sculptures, balancing beams, swings, tree trunk, climbing zone and a sandpit with dinosaur bones.

Belud Trail - 4.8km

Things to see: Medicinal plants and trees, sea cycad and long-tailed macaques

Timpak Pogimpaan Trail - 3.6km

Things to see: Medicinal plants and trees, sea cycad and long-tailed macaques

Lolobuhan Trail - 1.0km

Things to see: Insects, mammals, fig trees, palm species, medicinal plants and long-tailed macaques

Tindohuon Trail - 3.6km

Things to see: Medicinal plants, palm species, types of herb species, insects and long-tailed macaques

Nintorusan Trail - 4.6km

Things to see: Mammals including mouse deer, civet cat, western tarsier, slow loris, long-tailed macaques and insects

Ponitihan Trail - 3.6km

Things to see: Insects, mammals, fig trees, palm species, medicinal plants and long-tailed macaques

Nunuk Trail - 0.5km

Things to see: Insects, termite mounds, medicinal plants, palm species and reptiles
